




The Trinity Ridge Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is aromatic, deep, and earthy. Black and blue fruit flavors grace a richly textured palate that finishes long with firm tannins, and mineral and spice notes. This 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon garnered 97 Points from Jeb Dunnuck in May 2023. Trinity Ridge Vineyard is a spectacular 9-acre parcel at the height of elevation in the Moon Mountain District.

Lasseter wines are inspired by John and Nancy Lasseter's travels from California to the South of France and beyond. The estate property was an

early enclave for French winemakers in the 1800's, with heritage vineyards that have been painstakingly revitalized to create a vibrant ecosystem.

Danielle Langlois, Winemaker, considers Lasseter her dream job, reflecting her values of superb winemaking, collaboration, and stewardship of the land. Tony Biagi supports Lasseter as Consultant Winemaker. Lasseter Family Winery produces Bordeaux and Rhône inspired white, rosé, and red wines, as well as century-old Zinfandel. These wines are produced in small quantities and are only available direct from the winery.

2021 Ramey Chardonnay, Ritchie Vineyard

Legendary for its old Chardonnay vines and unusual mix of disparate soils, Ritchie Vineyard is regarded as a "California Grand Cru Chardonnay Vineyard." These 20 rows of Chardonnay were planted in 1972. Ramey Wine Cellars directly influenced 21st century winemaking and set a new standard for what California could achieve. Success in launching the family's namesake winery was not preordained. Starting from humble origins, through intellectual leadership and hands-on experience, Ramey has risen to be considered one of the iconic wineries of California.

The Ramey family has long excelled at collaborating with other multigenerational winegrowers to make single vineyard wines as well as blends that showcase the defining characteristics of their sites. The second generation, Claire and Alan Ramey, began working at the winery in 2013 and have been cross trained in all aspects of winery operations. In 2021, Claire and Alan became co-presidents of Ramey Wine Cellars. The vision is unwavering: to make classic wines from Sonoma and Napa that belong amongst the world's best.

Alan Ramey has completed harvest internships at Veramonte in Chile and Domaine Méo-Camuzet in Burgundy and competed on the blind tasting team for the University of Cambridge. He currently serves on the Board of the California Wine Institute.

RIDGE VINEYARDS

2022 Ridge Lytton Springs

Ridge Vineyards is proud to offer our 50th anniversary celebration of Ridge Lytton Springs, for the 2024 Sonoma Epicurean Barrel Auction! The 2022 vintage is composed of 67% Zinfandel, 19% Petite Sirah, 11% Carignane, 3% Alicante Bouschet, this approachable young wine, a classic zinfandel, will continue to evolve over the next ten to fifteen years.

Lytton Springs Vineyard is located on the bench and hills separating Dry Creek and Alexander Valleys, just north of Healdsburg, Sonoma County. An early spring and mild weather contributed to a uniform but moderate set. A May frost reduced yields in some blocks, but as each

parcel is on its own timing for bud break, most of the vineyard was spared. The rich fruit, refreshing acidity and firm tannin of this complex wine showcase the balance and quality typical of an exceptional vineyard.

In 1972, Ridge made its first Lytton Springs from vines planted on the eastern half of the vineyard at the turn of the century. Both the eastern and western portions of the vineyard were purchased in the early 1990s, (In the 1870s, under "Captain" William Litton's ownership, the two were part of one property; spelling evolved to "Lytton" by 1903.) The vineyard is planted to zinfandel and its principal complementary varietals.



2019 WALT Bob's Ranch Estate Vineyard 100% Pinot Noir

The WALT Estate, Bob's Ranch, lies alongside the region known as the Petaluma Wind Gap. This region is known for cooler temperatures due to the connection of fog and wind rolling along a pathway from Pacific Ocean thru the Bodega Bay and to the San Francisco Bay. Bob's Ranch encompasses diverse aspects along rolling hills and is planted with 17 distinct clones and heritage selections of Pinot Noir.

Producing the 2019 Bob's Ranch Pinot Noir begins in the vineyard, carefully selecting individual blocks of fruit that highlight the expressive, powerful

style of Pinot Noir. Typically the clusters in these blocks showcase millerandage, where tiny berries form alongside larger berries. The small berries provide purity of flavor and concentration, while the large berries in the clusters form the finesse of freshness and acidity. The result is a concentrated and focused Pinot Noir with profound fruit, savory texture, and vivid structure which will offer pleasure on release while also allowing for careful cellaring for years to come.

WALT is an independent family-owned winery founded by Craig Hall and Kathryn Walt Hall. WALT honors Kathryn's parents, Bob and Dolores Walt, who were grape growers in Mendocino since 1972 and nurtured Kathryn's passion for vineyards, wine and land stewardship. Today, WALT specializes in 1,000 Miles of Pinot Noir, sourcing fruit from four estate vineyards and meticulous grower partners from Oregon to Santa Barbara along the Pacific Coast.




